Music theory, sight reading, ear training, and memorization are included in regular private lessons as appropriate for the student's age and experience.

Attendance & Scheduling

- Lessons may be scheduled individually or on a monthly basis. Prices are the same, but scheduling monthly allows you to lock in a regular day & time for your lessons.
- Late arrivals will result in a shortened lesson without refund.
- To qualify for a makeup lesson, a minimum of 24 hours notice (via phone or email) is needed for cancellations EXCEPT in cases of illness or emergency.
 - If you schedule lessons monthly, no-shows and cancellations with less than 24 hours notice will not be refunded.
 - If you schedule lessons individually, excessive no-shows or cancellations with less than 24 hours notice may result in termination of the teaching contract.

Tuition & Payments

- Rates for 2025:
 - Per 30 minute lesson: \$20
 - Per 45 minute lesson: \$30
 - Per 60 minute lesson: \$40
- If lessons are scheduled individually, payment is due at the end of the lesson.
- If lessons are scheduled per month, payment is due at the first lesson of each calendar month.
- Payment is accepted via cash or Venmo.
- Late payments may result in the suspension of lessons until the balance is paid.

Student Expectations

- Students are expected to properly maintain their instrument.
- Students are expected to practice regularly and complete weekly assignments.
- Be prepared by always bringing your music and a pencil. If you play a string instrument, please also bring your rosin and a music stand.
- Progress depends on dedication and consistent effort outside of lessons.
- Have a metronome at home and use it during practice time as instructed.
- Be respectful at all times.
